Are we nearly there yet?

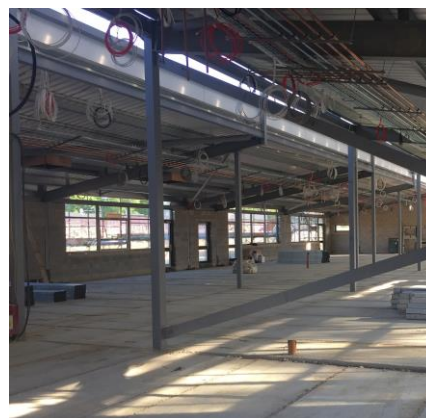
